Tuarangi House has been crafted in CLT pine to produce unique forms, so it was essential the product selected to finish the pine accentuated the timber in the best way possible. Architecturally, the house plays between the natural and the manufactured, with sharp black forms meeting natural materials, both inside and out. It was an obvious choice to select WOCA, a natural oil finish, to enhance the pine and provide a warm, natural feel to the interior.

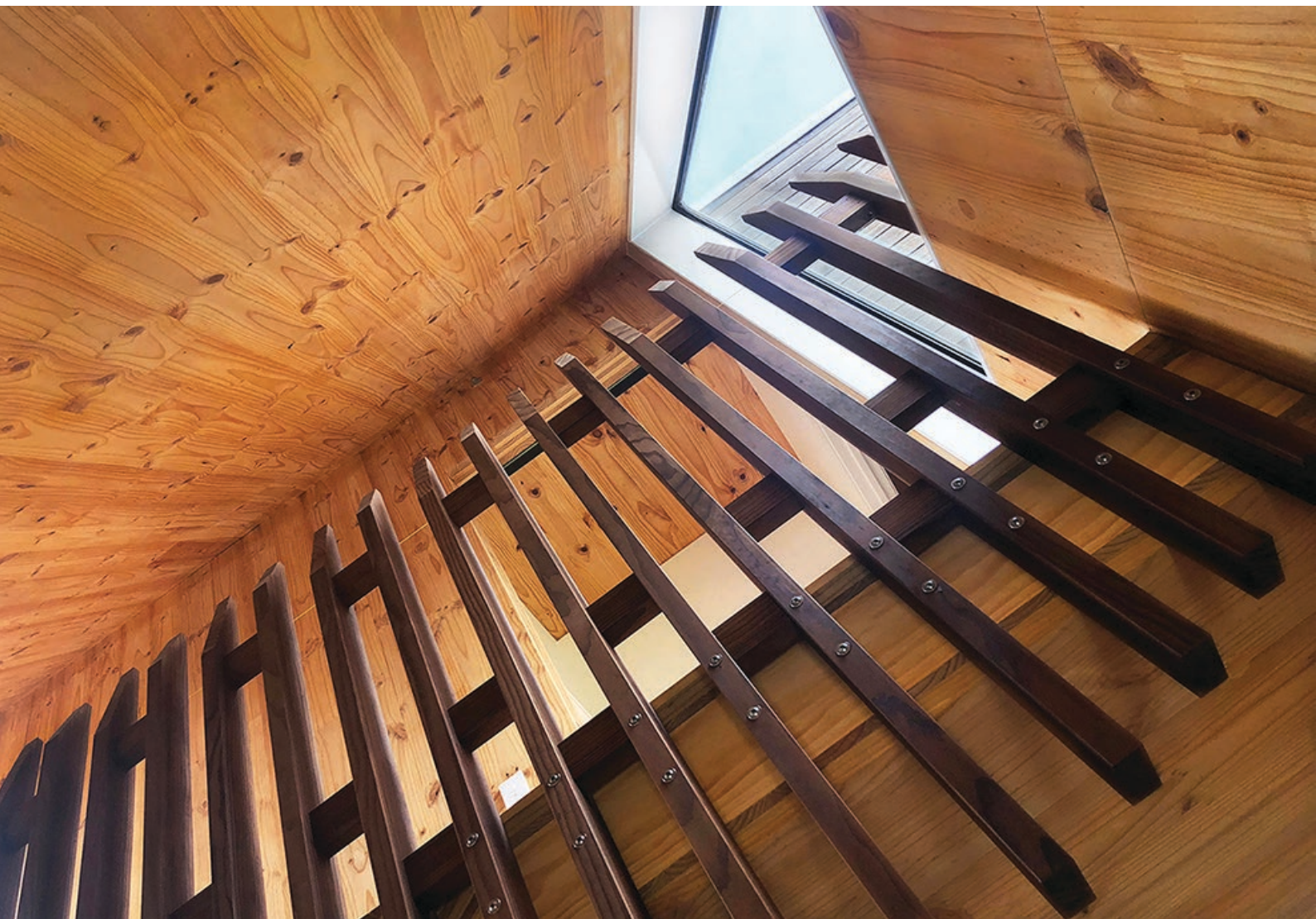

APPLICATION PROCESS

DIAMOND OIL



1. Apply WOCA Wood Cleaner, diluted 1:40 with water, to the clean, dry surface.
2. Apply Diamond Oil to the surface sparingly using a speed brush or roller. Allow the product to penetrate.
3. After 20 minutes, rub the oil into the wood with a cloth, nylon pad, or 360° gib tool.
4. Remove all excess from the surface with a clean cloth.
5. Dispose of cloths in a plastic bag containing water to avoid self-combustion.

The wood will be dry after 48 hours, and fully hard after 7 days.

Clean and maintain with WOCA Natural Soap, diluted 1:40.
